




TOEIC Reading




TOEIC Total Score







Score Development Rate (SDR)


SDR = (Post-Test Score – Pre-Test Score) / (Full Mark – Pre-Test Score) x 100






Oral Proficiency Interview - Computer

Discussion

Discussion

- Respondents gave higher ratings to the use of artificial intelligence than to practice with a human partner
- Less resistance to speaking English
- Not embarrassed even if they made mistakes
- Practice the same conversations repeatedly
- Practice whenever it was convenient for them
- Very useful learning materials for False Beginners who are not very good at practicing speaking against humans.
